DESCRIPTION GÉNÉRALE DU COURS :

This course is an introduction to some of the main topics of digital sociology. Digital technologies are now everywhere, so much that some authors talk about a “platformization of society”. The digital gives rise to analyses, debates and social movements that populate the public space between discourses of promise and of warning. It is today difficult to understand society without taking them into account, just as it is futile to try to understand the deployment of digital technologies without placing them into sociopolitical and economic spheres. To equip students with the tools to analyze the social and technical dynamics at work in digital transformations, this course draws on a series of works from sociology of the digital, of economics, of politics, of labor, as well as from philosophy. Students will learn, through a combination of lectures, texts and videos, a series of concepts and frameworks in order to understand the essential issues of the platform society. At the end of the course students will be able to better identify, analyze and evaluate digital issues, but also to recognize the implications of the interweaving of the social and the technical in their field of expertise.
