APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS				
MINIMUM GRADE	The applicant must be in the top third of their class for their major.			
LANGUAGE	The required language is Spanish. In case the applicant's native language is not Spanish, he or she must present a certificate of High Intermediate or greater Spanish. Official language certificates issued by the university of origin are accepted.			
REQUIRED DOCUMENTS	Submit at time of application: Motivation letter of no more than 1000 words, signed by the applicant Academic letter of recommendation Nomination letter from University of origin The University of origin registration certificate Official transcript of the University of origin UARM Incoming Academic Mobility Request Form (download here) Copy of valid passport Submit upon acceptance: UARM Undergraduate Registration Form, signed by the applicant Health Certificate indicating good physical and mental health Comprehensive health insurance coverage during entire stay in Peru 1 passport-size color photo with a white background			
CREDITS AND COURSES	A 3 credit course is equal to 3 hours of class time weekly and at least 3 hours of out-of-class work weekly. A 4 credit course is equal to 4 hours of class time weekly and at least 4 hours of out-of-class work weekly. Minimum number of credits permitted: 12 credits Maximum number of credits permitted: 20 credits NOTE: Courses from different majors can be taken, as long as the course content is related to the student's major at their university of origin.
