Nomination	The students need to be nominated by their home university. Later on, they will be informed about the online application procedure . Nomination deadlines are: For the winter semester: 1 May For the summer semester: 1 November Please include name, birth date, e-mail address, subject and term and send the nomination to admin.ess@wwu.de		
Application deadline	Students must hand in the application for admission to the Exchange Student Service : For the winter semester: 1 June For the summer semester: 1 December		
Language of instruction	Most courses are taught in German, only very few lectures and seminars are taught in English or other languages. There are no additional courses for exchange students. Please make sure to acquire some German skills before you arrive to Münster or concentrate on language courses at our university.		
Academic calendar	 The academic year is divided into two semesters: the winter semester starts in October, exams take place in February the summer semester starts in April, exams take place in July and August.
