
Moving into the dorm	Mid-February(before Orientation)

### Learning Mandarin

With more than 20 years of history in teaching Mandarin as a foreign language, the Chinese Language Center (CLC) at National Chengchi University (NCCU) aims to provide high-quality and flexible Mandarin courses for students around the world.

Chinese Language Center offers regular Mandarin Chinese courses 4 terms each year. Spring, Summer, and Fall term each last 12 weeks with a total 180 teaching hours; for Winter term, we provide a 10-week course with 150 teaching hours. All CLC courses are divided into beginning, intermediate, high-intermediate, and advanced levels.
