DESCRIPTION GÉNÉRALE DU COURS :

The seminar offers to understand the framework of multilateralism, starting by questioning its origins (who conceived it?), its philosophy (why convey it in this way?), and achievements. For this last point, we will consider the establishment of the universal institutions (the UN, the IMF, the GATT, the Commission on Human Rights...) and the regional institutions (the European Union, the African Union, Mercosur and Asean). This international system was particularly constructed under the influence of the United States, which became a world power in the aftermath of the war, and reflected both international priorities and national priorities. That is why we also talk about the American Century from 1945 to the present day.

This seminar will examine the challenges of multilateralism, starting from the current events and going back to the past, in order to better understand them, and also to question the relevance of multilateralism in a world in transition.
